WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY FORM

Event: Charity Gift Wrap Centre at Willowbrook Shopping Centre, December 7 - 24, 2016

Property: Willowbrook Shopping Centre

THIS IS A LEGAL AGREEMENT.

I propose to participate in the event named above (the "Event") at the above property (the "Property"), which is owned by the owner(s) listed above (the "Owner") and managed by Bentall Kennedy (Canada) Limited Partnership ("Bentall Kennedy").

I understand that a condition of the Owner allowing me on to the Property to participate in the Event is that I do so entirely at my own risk and agree that the Released Persons (defined below) will have no liability to me for any Injuries or Losses (defined below) that I may incur while I am on the Property in connection with the Event or that are otherwise caused by the Event, even if those losses are caused by one or more of the Released Persons.

This release and waiver is given in favour of the Owner, Bentall Kennedy, Bentall Kennedy (Canada) G.P. Ltd., their respective affiliates, and the directors, officers, shareholders, partners and employees of any of them (collectively, the "Released Persons" and individually a "Released Person").

I agree as follows:

- (a) **I assume all risks of participating in the Event** (the "Assumed Risks"), including (without limitation) personal injury to or death of me or another person, or loss of, damage to or theft of personal property, whether caused directly or indirectly by a Released Person or another person, whether directly caused by my participation or proposed participation in the Event or arising indirectly from such participation, including my travel to and from the Event.
- (b) I agree that the Owner and Bentall Kennedy shall have no responsibility to prevent Assumed Risks, or to take precautions to prevent injury to me or my death while I participate in the Event.
- (c) I release, waive and forever discharge (both on my own behalf and on behalf of my executors, administrators, heirs, and any other person who may claim through me or in respect of injury or death caused to me, such as a person claiming by virtue of section 61 of the *Family Law Act* (Ontario) or similar provisions of the legislation of another province) each of the Released Persons from any liability in respect of the Assumed Risks, whether or not caused or contributed to by the acts or omissions of the Released Persons, or any of them, even if such acts are negligent, grossly negligent or otherwise fail to meet a legal standard.
- (d) I agree not to make a claim in respect of an Assumed Risk against a Released Person or against a third party who has a right to make a claim for contribution or indemnity against a Released Person. I agree to indemnify each of the Released Persons for all losses (including reasonable legal fees) caused by my breach of this agreement.

I understand while participating in this activity, I may be photographed or have audio or video recordings made of me. I agree to allow any such photographs or recordings to be used for any legitimate purpose by Owner or Bentall Kennedy, and their respective assigns.

The Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form shall be construed broadly to provide a release and waiver to the maximum extent permissible under applicable law.
