Academic Remedial Classes

Students taking Academic Remedial classes must have already taken the course and received a mark of at least 35% but have not met the learning outcomes or have only done so at a minimal level. Students can take a maximum of two Remedial classes and will be able to earn the course credit and a **maximum** mark of 61% (C) in these 45 hour courses.

Math 8/9 Remedial or Preview

Students taking Academic Remedial Math 8 or 9 classes must have already taken the course and received a mark of at least 35% but have not met the learning outcomes or have only done so at a minimal level. Students will receive the course credit with the assigned mark in these 70 hour courses if they have previously taken the course. Students who have never taken Math 8 or 9 may "preview" either course to better prepare for the full course they take next year, **but will not receive credit.**

- ✓ Students are expected to attend all sessions of a class they are registered for. Absence of more than 2 days may result in withdrawal from courses. Students should not register if extended absence for any reason is anticipated (e.g. work, vacations, sporting events, family commitments).

Online Registration - Current Langley School District Students Only

Online registration is available only for current Langley School District students and is the quickest way to register.

Steps to register online at sd35.coresolutions.ca

- 1) Choose **“Create a new account”** or choose **“Use an existing account”** if student has registered before.
- 2) Once the account is created or you are logged in, choose **“Browse class offerings”** to see the available classes and register for the class you are interested in.
- 3) After you register, an e-mail will be sent to you confirming the registration is “Pending”.
- 4) A second confirmation e-mail will be sent to you or you will be contacted by the Summer Session staff, usually within seven days, once your registration is reviewed and it is “Approved”.

In-person Registration - Current Langley School District Students and Out of District Students

In-person registration is available starting on April 10, 2017. For out of district students who were not part of the Langley School District for the 2016/17 school year in-person registration is the only option.

Information required when registering:

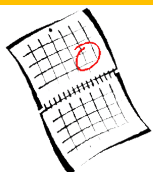
- Student’s PEN / Personal Education Number, a nine digit number located on report cards, permanent records or transcripts. Students should check with their current school ahead of time if they need assistance locating their PEN.
- Student’s legal and English name if different, phone number(s), address, and parent guardian(s) name(s) and e-mail address.
- If student was not registered in the Langley School District for the 2016/17 school year, proof of parent / guardian(s) Citizenship and BC residency plus the student’s birth certificate must be provided.

International Students

- International students already registered in the Langley School District should contact the International Student Program at the Langley School District Board Office or their school based ISP Coordinator before registering in Summer Session classes for full information regarding payment options and to confirm homestay arrangements.
- Middle Years students can register for their course online or in-person as outlined above. International students are subject to course fees as outlined on the front of this brochure.
- Payment of course fees must be made within 7 days of registration. International elementary students registrations must pay in person at the School District Board office by debit, credit card, cash or cheque. International Students withdrawing from courses are subject to a 10% processing fee. Refunds will not be given after July 10, 2017.
