This program supports the youth with the job training and work experience they need to succeed. This is designed to recognize their skills and gain confidence to obtain suitable employment in Canada.

### WHAT THE PROGRAM OFFERS:

- 6 weeks in class (paid while in class)
- Certifications on Food Safety, Basic First Aid, Cashier and Customer Service
- 10 weeks at the job
- Supports clients for a smooth transition into the Canadian labour market
- Career exploration based on individual assessments
- Job search guidance, resume, cover letter and interview preparation workshop
- One on one case management and support for youth clients facing multiple barriers for employment
- Accessing the hidden job market

### WHO CAN BE IN THE PROGRAM

- Clients between the ages of 15-30 years old
- A member of a visible or ethnic minority group
- Canadian citizens that face multiple barriers for employment: homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, living with family care responsibilities, affected by substance abuse, among others
- Recent immigrant and/or refugee in Canada of not more than 5 years
- Clients must be legally able to work in Canada
